BUS/TRAIN

There are many options that will come up on Google maps on your phone. If you are not arriving at peak rush hour the Logan Express Back Bay bus is likely your best option. It picks up at each terminal and is FREE to Back Bay. Your stop will be the second stop, 145 Dartmouth Street. You will be let off two short blocks from the hotel: https://www.massport.com/logan-airport/getting-to-logan/logan-express/back-bay.

If you are arriving at peak rush hour when traffic is at its worst, you might want to avoid Boston streets and catch the Blue Line train.

First, catch a shuttle from your terminal to the Blue Line train. Depending upon your terminal, the shuttle bus could be 22, 33, 55, or 66.

m Points of Interest

Within Walking Distance

<u>Boston Public Library</u> (across the street). The beauty of this 1895 Renaissance Revival building is such that it is a popular site for weddings. The John Singer Sargent mural series is especially worth seeing.

<u>Museum of Fine Arts</u>. One of the nation's best art museums. Among other paintings, see those by John Singleton Copley, including his portrait of Paul Revere. Copley Square was named for John Singleton Copley.

<u>Boston Common</u>. The oldest public park in the U.S. and the starting point for the <u>Freedom Trail</u>. The 2.5 mile self-guided Freedom Trail connects 16 historic sights.

<u>Boston Public Garden</u>. Adjacent to the Boston Common is America's oldest botanical garden, including a four-acre lagoon with swan boats.

Beyond Walking Distance, but Still Close

Beacon Hill. A neighborhood of lovely Federal style homes, near the MA state house.

<u>North End</u>. One of the country's most famous Italian communities. Besides historic sights, such as Paul Revere's House, there are many good Italian restaurants.

Within Walking Distance

<u>Symphony Hall</u>. Home to the Boston Symphony Orchestra and the Boston Pops.

Prudential Center. Catch a <u>Boston Duck Tour</u> for a land-and-water tour of the city or go to the 52nd floor of the Prudential Tower for a panoramic view of the city (<u>viewboston.com</u>).

For those who like to shop, the hotel is connected via enclosed walkways to two shopping centers, Copley Place and the Prudential Center. Newbury Street is also a ten minute walk away.

We Bostonians take great pride in our city and its rich history, doing our best to preserve the sites and structures that have played an important role in the story of America. For over 40 years, Old Town Trolley has provided Boston sightseeing tours highlighting the best of the city.

Stop #12 - Copley Place Mall (100 Huntington Ave, Boston, MA)
Tickets Sold at this Stop. Stop #12 is directly outside of the revolving door entrance to
Copley Place, below the elevated glass foot bridge.

Stop #13 - Copley Square / Trinity Church (Boylston St & Clarendon St, Boston, MA). Directly across the street from #545 Boylston Street. Stop #13 is on Boylston Street on the north side of Trinity at the bus shelter near the Phillips Brooks Statue.

Beyond Walking Distance, but Still Close

Harvard Square. See Harvard's historic campus. Visit the <u>Harvard Art Museums</u> (free). Listen to jazz at the <u>Charles Hotel's Regattabar</u> or to folk music at <u>Passim</u>.
