THE UNIT VALUATION OF PUBLIC UTILITIES FOR AD VALOREM TAX PURPOSES

The Department of Economics of Wichita State University will conduct a four-day program on "The Unit Valuation of Public Utilities For Ad Valorem Tax Purposes" from August 13 to August 16, 1973, at Clinton Hall, Wichita State University.

Purpose

The program is designed to study in detail the unit valuation of public utilities for ad valorem tax purposes. The various indices of value and the application of the indices will be considered, with particular emphases on capitalized earnings and cost.

Financial Arrangements and Accommodations

Students and faculty will be housed in Fairmount Towers on the Wichita State campus. The cost per participant for double room occupancy including three meals daily and the Monday night reception is \$35.00. (Single room occupancy is available at an additional cost of \$15.00.) The registration fee is \$20 for tax administrators and academicians, and \$55 for industry representatives. This makes a total cost of \$55.00 and \$90.00 (double occupancy) excluding personal items and transportation. Registration fees are due by August 1 and the balance of cost upon arrival.
