The closest airport to The Westin Pittsburgh is **Pittsburgh International Airport (PIT)**. PIT is located approximately 17.9 Miles from the hotel. ONE HOUR IN PITTSBURGH

Only have an hour to spend in Pittsburgh? The city is full of exciting experiences that don't require reservations or a lot of time. Even if you only have as little as one hour to explore, these must-see spots will give you an expedited Pittsburgh experience.



EXPLORE THE POP DISTRICT

Pittsburgh has countless public art displays, and one of the newest is part of The Andy Warhol Museum's Pop District. If you're pressed for time and can't explore all seven floors of this museum dedicated to the work and life of Pittsburgh's own Andy Warhol, you can take in (and take selfies at) the colorful installation just outside the venue. Pop inside and explore the museum's fantastic gift shop for uniquely Pittsburgh mementos and grab a coffee at the Warhol Café.



TAKE THE INCLINES TO MT. WASHINGTON

Take in the iconic Pittsburgh skyline while riding one of our two signature funiculars up the side of Mt. Washington. The Monongahela Incline, next to Station Square and easily accessible via bus routes, light rail or car, will provide a spectacular view and drop you off at Shiloh Street in Mt. Washington. Grab a sweet treat at Grandview Bakery and take in the view from one of Grandview Avenue's observation pods.



STROLL IN THE STRIP DISTRICT

Pittsburgh's Strip District is a busy and dense business corridor filled with specialty markets, retail stores and restaurants. Stroll down Penn Avenue for sightseeing and shopping. Visit Wholey's fish market and Pennsylvania Macaroni Co – referred to locally as Pennmac – for some Pittsburgh staples. Take a turn down 18th Street for a Primanti Bros. sandwich, a signature food of the 'Burgh: two slices of thick Italian bread, stacked with meat, cheese, coleslaw and french fries. It's perfect to grab on the go.
